Fire Chief S. DeRosa

 Year to date calls total 905 with 47% being EMS. The EMS percentage is lowered from last month due to the 240+ storm related calls this past 6-days.

- Lt. Short and I will be meeting with Dr. Cushman this Friday to discuss the EMS Program at North Greece and to begin reviewing EMS responses. More to follow. I'd add Lt. Short is doing a great job with our EMS programs, purchases and training.
- Chief's Office is currently reviewing all fire responses for North Greece. Additionally, the IR
 component of our paging system will be turned off for North Greece at 8 AM tomorrow. This
 will eliminate two digital pages for every fire event we're dispatched to.
- The Explorer Post is reactivated effective March 7th but the review process by the Board of Directors and Chief's Office continues.
- Requesting permission for the department to participate in 4 upcoming parades provided there
 are no emergencies within the fire district and we have adequate staffing. One parade is the
 Town of Greece for Memorial Day.

 responses to the wind storm. In all, 240 storm related calls, 2 minor fire events and lots of
 service calls were addressed with no personal injuries or apparatus related incidents. We do
 have a list of items that need to be addressed including our former communications area, the
 updating to the Town's Emergency Response Plan and a future site for a town wide command
 post. More to follow.
- A special thanks to Walt, Tina, Kari, Pete, Andy & Tom Grenga for their extra efforts at the
 onset of this storm. Stellar performances by this staff to assist Captain Battaglia getting set up
 and addressing all the needs of the first responders town wide and addressing calls and walkins from our citizens.
- The Fire Chief has been asked to sit with police chief and the Town Supervisor regarding the town emergency center. This past event will probably be the last event we host here. The new police department has an emergency center included.
- The town will stay in a state of emergency through tonight.
- Comm. Camiolo thanked the Fire Chief for his phenomenal job during the event.
- A procedure will be forthcoming for future extended events.

• Engine 274 will be out of service for 2-3 weeks. It is having the same problem as 273 did last year. It will need the motor redone due to an undetected oil leak. The engine did not burn up. It will cost around \$13,000. E-273 has 80,000 miles on it and E-274 has over 100,000 miles on it. Would like to get started on the purchase of new engines. There was a short discussion regarding purchasing through bids or the Texas Consortium. For sure a Mandatory referendum will be needed to purchase. Comm. MacKenzie will speak with our attorney for the needed motions.

Commissioner J. Meath

- Great communication from the chief's office during the town-wide wind emergency event.
- The cell phone policy will be discussed at the next meeting. Comm. Camiolo would like to add into the policy that we should get a phone number from those that are getting reimbursement for cell phones.

Commissioner L. Andreano

- Greece Fire Council update: Chief Kevin Bardeen from the airport will be the guest speaker at the May meeting. He has an interesting presentation.
- We sustained roof damage at station 1 from the wind last week. We will be getting an estimate for repairs. We are not in a position to need an emergency enclosure. We also lost four trees that will be removed once the weather warms up. There is much work to be done once the weather clears. Due to the amount of work, some work will wait until next year.
- We are tracking cost from this wind incident. The threshold for submission to FEMA would be \$7.7 million for the county. We should be able to reach that. The governor has not answered to this yet.
