A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NORTH GREECE FIRE DISTRICT OF THE TOWNS OF GREECE AND PARMA, COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF NEW YORK TO AMEND THE "NORTH GREECE FIRE DISTRICT SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM.

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of the North Greece Fire District, Towns of Greece and Parma, County of Monroe, State of New York, hereby resolves as follows:

- Section 1. The North Greece Fire District contracts with the North Greece Fire Department, Inc. located within the North Greece Fire District for fire protection within the district.
- Section 2. The Board of Fire Commissioners of the North Greece Fire District, pursuant to Article 11-A of the General Municipal Law after a mandatory referendum established the North Greece Fire District Service Award Program (the Plan) with an effective date of the program of January 1, 1993.
- Section 3. The Plan document of the North Greece Fire District, is referenced herein and made a part hereof.

- Section 4. The plan was established for the volunteer firefighters of the North Greece Volunteer Fire Company and is a defined benefit plan, as that term is defined in Section 219 of the General Municipal Law.
- Section 5. The North Greece Fire District retains Penflex, Inc. to assist them in the administration of the "North Greece Fire District Service Award Program".
- Section 6. Pursuant to Article 11A of the New York State General Municipal Law Section 216, paragraph 3e, the point system adopted by the governing board may be amended by the affirmative vote of at least sixty percent of such governing board, without referendum, provided that the only effect of the amendment is to decrease the number of points granted for the performance of an activity.
- Section 7 This resolution shall amend the existing point accumulation activity schedule as follows

Section 8. The changes to the North Greece Fire District Service Award Program are to take effect on January 1, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the North Greece Fire District Service Award Program point systems is amended as provided herein effective January 1, 2018.

Chief's Report

- AC Meyers vehicle was turned in as planned and promised. His number and the title have been maintained but the position is not going to be filled for the foreseeable future.
- The Chief sent an email of inquiry to Barnard for the \$900 unpaid invoice but has received no feedback for inspections. The program has been working and there are 20 some entries made through August.
- We have been experiencing issues with the UPS in the building. When the generator test occurs every Monday, we lose our servers. It has taken everything out. We have called Penn Power Systems who tested the voltage and amperage. Everything is testing normal. It is not the throw over. We have replaced the server batteries. There is a potential issue with an overhead door motor caused by this. Skywave will send a technician on Tuesday. There is to be no test for the generator on Monday. We are still having a modem problem in the front of the building. Our servers at least 6 years old. It will probably be batteries plus UPS units.
- We have five new members in the FF I class for March. We will meet next week to do a pre
 FFI training program starting in January. Four are taking Interior FF and one is doing exterior
 only.
