- The resolution for the LOSAP increase has been completed by Firefly and sent to our attorney for his approval/suggestions.
- Oral swab testing will be added to our random drug pull next month. This testing can be done as soon as they walk in the door.

Fire Chief S. DeRosa

- There have been 1,002 alarms, year to date, 53% of those were EMS.
- The grass fire truck is out for bids, with an opening set for May 25th.
- Pump testing was cancelled last week due to weather conditions. It will be done in the next 2
 weeks.
- The hose approved last month has been ordered. It should be delivered in the next 4–5 months. We will not be sending out any hose for cutting until the delivery date gets closer.
- The money from Eckert Training has been received for the repairs to the burn building. MSH Fabrication is the contractor, and he has the money in hand, material is being ordered for repairs later this month. MSH estimates 2-3 days to complete the work once it starts.

- Administrative Orders 11 & 12 are appended to these minutes. These Orders reflect changes to officer assignments and group changes for all 4 battalion chiefs. Orders take effect May 19 and June 1.
- Lt. Dorgan will be attending FLSTP Training at FDNY on May 17-28 and will be driving the Ford Interceptor Fleet Number 4074. All travel arrangements have been finalized.
- The Quanti-Fit Test Machine is back in service at Headquarters.
- FF Peter Smith has announced his retirement, effective end of January 2022. More information will forth come later in the year.
- The training ground gate is going to be repaired tomorrow.

- Tractor Lease update: The dealer is trying to find one in the system as they are in high demand. The blade and forks have been ordered.
- Empire gave us an estimate to replace the backflow preventer at station 1 of \$1740. We are waiting for pricing for the unit at station 3 as it also failed.
